2 Consider the running track itself. Old cinder tracks absorbed energy from a runner's legs, while modern rubber tracks return energy with every step, helping runners go faster for the same effort.

3 Clothing matters too. Tight, lightweight fabrics now reduce wind and water resistance. Swimsuits modeled on shark skin let swimmers move more smoothly, and lightweight shoes give runners extra momentum.

4 Beyond gear, sensors have entered the picture. Smart clothing can monitor heart rate, breathing, and blood oxygen, warning long-distance athletes when they need to drink water.
